CRYSA Administrators Report September 8, 2008

Yes our summer has come to an end and it is time again to hit the soccer pitch. A lot has happened since our last meeting.

Registration numbers are way down as a result of our economy and lower enrollment in our school systems. We are not the only community hit with low enrollment. The province is down almost 8000 students.

We have lost 3 REP teams as a result of this and most of the players that did tryout have decided to play house. Out of a possible 16 REP and super 8 teams we have 9 teams entered into the UISA league.

Lower Island has decided not to interlock with UISA. AT the strategic meetings they felt it was not equitable to interlock with UISA.

No one from our club attended the last UISA meeting, and as a result forms and other material were left behind and we have no game report forms for UISA league play. We also have no ID card sheets and new stickers.

Our Registration Committee has met several times to deal with player requests. One decision was made and appealed. The original decision was then over turned. The Committee now needs to get direction from the Board as to rewriting our policy statement on REP players wishing to play up. As it sits now, the wording is specific on the criteria, but the date's conflict with tryouts and appointing of coaches.

Fall house league starts on Saturday September 13th and UISA league starts on Sunday September 14th. Please check the UISA website for your away games, your home games are listed on home page calendar. You must contact your Administrator if you need to change your schedule. The UISA scheduler will only deal with the Administrator and no one else.

I would advise every coach to down load the coach's package off the UISA website and read and understand it. Clubs will be fined for any deviation of their policies.

Henry Roller has agreed to put on a couple mini coaching clinics for all the new coaches. Monday Night 6 – 7pm at Pinecrest Park and Friday Night 6:30 – 7:30pm at the same location.

Coach meetings for TOTS to Under 10 have been scheduled for Tuesday September 9th and U11 to U18 have been scheduled for Wednesday September 10th starting at 7pm on

both nights for coaches to fill out their risk management forms and to pick up their equipment and uniforms.

As usual we have the same problem every year tracking coaches and players down for not registering before practices or tryouts. Same goes for the uniform deposits. If you don't pay you cannot play. Those players are not registered players and therefore have no insurance and jeopardize everyone else.

I have contacted Thrifty Foods about oranges. They will have one card per team in each age group so each team should send one delegate to get their card and oranges for each week of play.

Our website home page has your game times and fields listed so pass this information onto your parents and players. Also make sure that you understand that when the website says the fields are closed that you honour that request.
