January 12, 2009

Welcome everyone to a brand new year. Our 2008 fall house league came to an end on December 13th with an indoor windup at the Sportsplex. Although not every team participated in the final windup the overall response was very positive.

I would like to thank Quality Foods for donating all the hotdogs and buns and the Real Canadian Super Store for donating all the refreshments. I would also like to thank everyone that helped out with set up, cooking, serving and cleanup. Without your help this event would not have happened.

Our Futsal program is going into the second half of the season with it finishing on February 27th. Although the response was only half of what we expected a lot of positive has come out of it. The purchase of the 4 i-Goals has been an eye opener with positive comments in the program as well as the fall windup.

Our soccer phone number has now changed from 250-923-2493 to 1-866-964-GOAL. The Administrators phone is 250-287-2192 which is attached to the 1-866 number which will never change, only the Administrators number. Grant Signs have been asked to change the number on our clubhouse sign.

We have purchased 4 sets of Scoremaster goals to replace the worn out TEKK goals at a cost of close to \$8000. They have arrived and will have to be put together and transported to Georgia Park School when convenient.

Our website has been cleaned up and a few things will be added as the New Year progresses. Byte Size Coaching has changed their website as well as the link to our website. Coaches will be given a login and password from the club. The new format will be challenging as coaches once they have logged on will have the ability to see all usage of statistics at a stroke of a key.

Schedules for both spring and fall house league will have their own webpage so coaches and everyone else will have access to see where they play.

Teams participating in the UISA schedule for the New Year were to start on January 11th but due to snow still sitting on most fields and others closed due to too much moisture will commence on January 18th. Team managers and officials should be checking our website as well as UISA's website for updates on field closures and game times. It is up to the home to inform visiting teams of game cancelations due to field closures.

Rep and JD fees are due by January 15th as well as any final roster changes prior to Provincial Cup play.

Uniform returns have been quite a challenge, there are still over 110 of them still out there.

Spring Registration dates have been set (Feb 21/28 & March 7) registration forms are now on the website. Season is scheduled to start on April 5th and finish on June 28th. All teams will be playing no earlier than 12pm on Sundays and will not be playing Easter Sunday.

Sponsor campaign is now under way. Both Geoff and myself will be canvassing the local businesses for new and existing sponsorships for the 2009/2010 season.
