CRYSA ADMINISTRATORS REPORT MARCH 2007

Clubhouse. We may need to have additional storage for our nets that is accessible to our coaches in the form of an outside steel lockup. Sean Arbour is checking this option out.

Fields have been closed more than they have been open for quite some time due to the really wet weather conditions.

Pinecrest Park looks like a battlefield after the City has begun work on the fencing and mowing strips. This has been compounded by vandals driving on the playing surface. However the fields will be ready for Spring.

Tots on Pinecrest Park from 12 to 1 followed by the U10's with two fields. U6 and U7 on the Robron minis, U8 and U9 on two fields each at Pinecrest School, and the U11/12 at Robron Oval. The U13 and up will be at Cedar. This leaves us the option of Rockland.

Spring League Registration has been ongoing with two live registrations on Feb 24 and March 3. Our final live registration is on March 24th. Thanks to our excellent volunteers. I believe that we have about 450 players registered so far. It appears that our online option has been very successful.

The spring sponsorship and shirt program is moving along quite well

Providing equipment has been a bit of a problem so far but there is definitely reason to celebrate as we have received our Umbro nets, and CRYSA has entered into an

agreement with Tekk to supply several nets this year and some again next. We may be ordering more Umbro goals if Gary gives us the thumbs up after his trial. I have ordered one more set of Pugg nets to give us the option of the Tots using them. We will be ordering shirts for the Tots Fall program.

Sponsors have been a very pleasant surprise this year with two new majors plus many new levels 1 and 2's.

Cup play has been ongoing with several disappointments to go along with our victories in U12 Girls, U14 boys and U16 girls. Congratulations to all competing teams. The Home Hardware U12 girls were successful also in their semi final Coastal Cup game. Now is the time for all U12 and up teams to turn in their equipment if they are not involved in cup play

Best wishes to the U14 boys as they take off to England for a cultural and soccer experience early this week.
