Campbell River Youth Soccer Administrators Report October 15th, 2007

I am happy to say that everything is going alright. The season is well underway and into our 6th week without too many disruptions.

Fields are looking fine and Wayne has been very busy making sure all the lines are kept up as well helping out with the schools and the Fighting Eagles football club. With all the rain we have had lately, we have only had to shut the fields down for one day.

Locks for the fields were at a loss, and now I have ordered more and received new locks. The lower mini Robron goals have been unlocked from the beginning of the season and now we can lock them up.

Washrooms at Robron Park are now open, please respect them and take care of them. They are open to the public, cleaned on a regular basis and are locked up in the evenings.

UISA is still struggling with their new Administrator but things are finally coming into place. Our league fees and BCSA assessment fees are in, as well as our player registrations. Under 12 teams are not part of the UISA league and therefore we don't pay league fees to UISA.

ID cards are now completed with just a few players who need to get their pictures into me. Coaches or team representatives must sign and be responsible for these cards. The ID cards are not to be handed out to the players and must be in the possession of a team official at all games. Teams who do not present their cards to the game officials will be reported and the club will be fined. Teams who do not have their cards after the 1st of November will forfeit their games.

Team pictures are to be taken by Ken Bell Photography on October 13th and 20th weekends at Pinecrest school.

Class 4 referee clinic went ahead, considering only 7 individuals signed up for the course, only 6 paid and took the course and 5 passed the exam. As per BCSA guidelines, we are billed as if 15 took the course. Our protocol is to reimburse everyone who took the course and passed it.

UISA schedules and procedures on game cancellations: It has been brought to the attention of the UISA board that some teams or clubs are not following the proper procedure in game cancellations or postponements. Please follow the guidelines on the UISA website.

Please look at the UISA schedule on a regular basis as it changes from week to week.

Island Cup play downs are scheduled for November 3 and 4th weekend, with the November 17th and 18th weekend as a back up. Be prepared to play both days depending on how many teams are entered in each age group. You can view the formats on the UISA website at www.leaguelineup.com/uisoccer . Our club is slated to host the U13 boys age group, but UISA are asking us to switch with Alberni due to the fact that they don't have U13 girls team. This needs to be discussed by our membership.

UISA is asking our club if we would be interested in hosting the Island Cup Final event in April. They say that it will involve 12 games on ¾ fields over one day. I have asked for more details.

The Field User Fee Advisory Group is preparing to spend Field User Fees on field improvements for 2008. The deadline for proposals is 4pm on November 27th, 2007. Also, the Advisory Group along with the City are going to meet in the future on a regular basis on would like more feed back from all the User groups on wants and needs.

Registration is considered closed but will still except registrations if teams want more players. I have the totals which I have handed out in a separate report as the Registrar and you can see that we are down in every age group. Please note that in the Under 10 age group there are 5 players unassigned and that represents 5 players who have elected to just be in the JD program.

Thanks to Robert Godel, Brad Anderson, Susan Leask and Collin Nemeth for taking the time to get the Under 13/15 girls and Under 16/18 mixed drop-in groups off the ground.

Those coaches who have booked gym time can now go into the gyms for practices. I informed the School District Office and they have instructed the school custodians. If you still want to book a gym there are still times available but I would suggest that you talk to me personally rather than emailing me.

The Homerdome and All Weather Field practices: because of the homerdome's size, only one team can practice there at a time, but you still have to book it through me. The All Weather Field can be shared but also has to be booked through me, otherwise it will be overbooked.

Sponsors for REP teams, I have only received payment and confirmation for two sponsors: Intersport (level 3) and Econo U Store-it (level 4) I will be following up by personally talking to the other sponsors who previously had committed.
