### **Registration Report:**

Total of 673 children registered at present with a total of 19 players that have asked for refunds. This total is not far off from last years fall registrations.

### **Sponsors Report:**

Home Hardware is sponsoring the U12 girls group. There was some discussion over the possibility of getting new sponsors for the TOTS group.

### **Field Report:**

All our fields are in excellent shape due to the great weather we have had. Wayne Wilson who has been our field liner has agreed to be our Director in charge of fields. ### **Technical Report:**

### **Unfinished Business:**

From the previous minutes Gary moved that we pass the motion that read: That next fall league registration be one week later. Second by Sean Arbour, carried. This would mean that our final registration date for next fall would be September the 8<sup>th</sup> and league startup would be September 22<sup>nd</sup>.

Tag Day is set for June 16<sup>th</sup>, with June 17<sup>th</sup> and the 24<sup>th</sup> as live registration dates for the fall program.

Dates for Spring registration need to be addressed at the next meeting.

### **New Business:**

There seemed to be some confusion over JD costs and David explained that all players involved in the JD programs have to be properly registered to be part of the association and the groups involved. He also explained that there was no need for JD fees, but Sid stepped in and said that David could not make that decision on his own and that the membership needs to be evaluated the situation. Henry said that he would discuss the alternatives at the October 17<sup>th</sup> meeting that he was going to have with the coaches and come back to the club with resolutions.

Gary suggested that an informational email be sent out to all development teams about fees required by the club by certain dates. The club fees for development teams are \$75 , of which \$25 is paid up by October 31<sup>st</sup> and the remaining \$50 by January 31<sup>st</sup>.

There has been 2 complaints filed about one of our coaches in the 13/15 girls group, in regards to being tardy to practices and games. They also made it known that there are people out there willing to help out in this matter. David said that he would ask the coach if there was a problem and whether or not it would be okay to get some more help.

Susan Leask, manager of the U16 girls group, has asked for some clarification on the UISA rules of competition for Island Cup play. Graham has been directed to find out the answers from UISA.

The fall season seems to have kicked off rather well even though there were the usual small concerns. Goalposts left out, late registrations, etc.

I have had several requests for the risk management B form. This should be more readily available to our members so possibly this should be on the new website.

I have been in contact with the SD 72 and the gym permits should all be ready.

Ken Bell has been at three picture sessions so far and all appears to be going well. There will be a session on Oct 21. If you have missed out please call Ken at 923-6780 for a time slot.

I am no longer involved with registering players outside of the live registrations. This will now be handled by the registrar David Wood. 287-4842.

UISA league play has also begun. There was an unfortunate incident in a game against CVU with a CVU player suffering a broken leg. There has been a remarkable amount of fallout regarding this game and it has negatively affected the positive relationships that had been forged between the two teams. Unfortunately blame was incorrectly laid at the feet of our coach and player by the opposing coach who wasn't even at the game.

UISA has backed the referee in his assessing no foul, and the opposing coach has been told to tone it down.....again. This matter is now closed.

Pinnies have been ordered in various sizes, they are now ready for use, and also goalie shirts. These 20 shirts are black with silver trim. They will have our logo installed and a number 1.

We also have a small compressor in the equipment room so that balls can be inflated prior to the start of the season.

This has been quite a hectic period but now things have settled down somewhat.

Once again I am asking that I step back from the registration committee chair position, as I had no intention of making that a part of the Administrators duties when I made the original motion.

Wayne Wilson has agreed to take on the fields' directors' position. Thanks Wayne.  
Please be aware that no marking of the fields will take place this week for Oct 21 and 22 games.  
Once again the lock at Pinecrest School has been removed.

Congratulations to the new class 4 referees! We really need you! Once again I must stress the importance of being supportive of all of our officials because we can't play the game without them!
