**Campbell River Youth Soccer Administrators Report  
September 10<sup>th</sup>, 2007**

Welcome everyone to the 2007/2008 season. As usual there is a rush to get everything ready.

Coaches meetings for the TOTS to U10 are set for Tuesday September 11 at 7pm at the clubhouse. As stated on several occasions coaches will not receive equipment unless they have filled out their risk management form. U11 and up coaches meetings are set for September 12<sup>th</sup> at the same time.

Wayne has started off well by getting all the fields for UISA lined for their first weekend of play on the 9<sup>th</sup> of September as well as coaching the U14 girls. Everyone expected to start on the 15<sup>th</sup> but UISA dropped the bomb on us to start a week earlier, we were ready but some other clubs were not and they weren't supposedly informed of some schedule changes and had to scramble for fields.

UISA has lost their Administrator after 2 weeks on the job and we now have to work with their Assistant, Steve Walton. Coaches are reminded that all scores have to be reported to me and I pass them onto UISA. ID Cards to come into effect after the 15<sup>th</sup> of October, I will be scheduling the times and dates for pictures.

We are definitely in need of some direction as we have two particular age groups of players with no one to play and no coaches. I am referring to the U13/15 girls and the U16/18 mixed players. To every ones surprise and mine there will be no team in UISA

for U16 to U18 girls and no team in U17 to 18 boys. I wonder why? We have 50 kids and nowhere to play. We may have to refund their money. This is very disappointing.

There are only 556 registered, that's 200 down from previous years and if we refund the 50 we will just top 500. Something has to be done to attract more players to this sport for fall soccer or we will mainly have to focus on our spring program.

Allison/Susan and their crew have been working like little beavers to get their equipment in order. If we can keep these people doing the excellent job they have been doing, we won't have any problems with our equipment. There will be some changes in this department that some of you won't approve of but equipment is expensive and you must take care of it.

Gym booking must go through me, they will not be accepted by anyone else through the School Board office. We have lost some of our bookings due to the fact we never used some of the school gyms last year.

Practices cannot be booked, only games and friendlies. They must be done through me as well. All school fields are open for practices on a first come first serve basis. Please try and use the green space around the fields and stay away from the goal areas as they are the first to show wear and tear.

When fields are closed please respect the closure. If anyone is caught using the fields during closures, there are dire consequences. Loss of use to the field and possible suspensions.

I have a schedule for practicing at the Homerdome and the All weather field under the lights, it's on a first come first serve basis and I do the bookings.

Team pictures will be taken again by Ken Bell Photography, I haven't received the envelopes yet, but schedules will be posted.

I'm hoping the weather will co-operate with us this season so we can get as many games played as possible.
