The registration of players for the fall league is almost completed and our numbers are marginally lower than last year, however some divisions are full and registration is ongoing.

Wayne lined as many fields as possible before he was halted by rain but the season start was a success. There is a set of mid size goalposts at the Robron Oval that needs to be brought up to the clubhouse Thanks to our new Division Managers, David Wood, Stacey Chow, Kelly Bellefleur, Lee Waterton, Jim Anderson, Al Barker, Piers Jackman, Steve Koebel and returning Division managers Troy Perras and Charlene Friedrichs.

They have been an excellent addition to our club and have made my job, which can be incredibly chaotic at this time of year, so much easier to do.

Karen and I have registered over 160 players at our home.

Coaches meetings were held on Wednesday September 6th and were well attended. Karen and Susan issued team shirts while I issued the balls, cones, nets and corner flags. David handed out the coaches manuals and dealt with risk management.

It seemed to go reasonably well, thanks in no small part to the organization of the space for equipment by Karen, Susan and Emily.

However I had indicated that I would like to step down after completing the inventory. This has now been done. Susan Leask has agreed to stay on and be the shirts equipment manager if Karen would join her and I would stay to look after nets, balls, cones etc. I have agreed to do this.

Some age groups are restricted by the number of shirts in making up team sizes, while other ages have a huge array of colours and sizes. We may need to purchase some shirts to cover the middle age groups.

Perhaps we should consider issuing soccer shirts in the spring for some age groups so that we can utilize the shirts that we have.

I have completed all schedules and the picture schedule. This will be distributed shortly. Presently I am working on a Gym schedule and team sponsorship. Please let me know as soon as you are able if you need a gym. My budget is for \$2000.

The UISA schedule hasn't been completed as yet because not all clubs have sent in their team lists. This includes CRYSA.

I have stepped down as chair of the registration committee as I had indicated earlier and my place has been taken by Annie Ledlin. Please direct all concerns to Annie.

We will be having a Rep team meeting after the Icebreaker. Hopefully I will have the socks and shorts that were ordered for several rep teams.

We will be holding a Referee Class 5 clinic on October 20 which is a Pro D Day. It will be at Timberline starting at 9am. There will be more details to come. Please call me at 923-2493 to register. A class 4 referee clinic will be held on September 21, 22 and 23 at the School board offices. Registration has to be made to BC Soccer and a \$50 fee paid. This fee will be reimbursed by CRYSA upon successful completion of the course.

The new CRYSA website is taking shape thanks to David Coates however there isn't a time frame that the site will be fully functioning due to work commitments. I am sure that this new site will be a very interesting, colourful, informative and user friendly tool for us all so keep your fingers crossed that it will be here soon.
